1. Roll Call of Town Board Members. (Note Public present: None.)
2. Public Comments. None
3. Approval of Minutes for the May 13, 2014 meeting. **Motion by Trustee Sheahan to approve the Minutes of the May 13, 2014 meeting of the Board. Motion seconded by Trustee Fuller. Motion approved unanimously.**
4. Approval of Claims for the period May 14, 2014 to June 10, 2014

6. Prevailing Wage Ordinance

Discussion commences on objection to Prevailing Wage Ordinance. Supervisor Pierce advises the Prevailing Wage Ordinance is mandated; we are required to pass the ordinance. Trustee Andersen states that we agree to pay Prevailing Wage, but we are against Prevailing Wage. Trustee Cantwell states this is a mandated vote for something we don't believe in. Discussion continues. Supervisor Pierce advises he will make motion.

a. Road District

**Motion by Supervisor Pierce to pass a Prevailing Wage Ordinance for the Dorr Township Road District, we have in the past paid prevailing wage and will in the future, but we do not agree with mandated**

prevailing wage, Motion made under protest. Motion seconded by Jon Sheahan, under protest. Vote called; Board polled: Trustee Sheahan - yes; Trustee Fuller - yes; Trustee Cantwell - no; Trustee Andersen - no; Supervisor Pierce- yes. Motion passed under protest.

b. Dorr Township

Motion by Supervisor Pierce to pass a Prevailing Wage Ordinance for Dorr Township, we have in the past paid Prevailing Wage and will in the future, but we do not agree with mandated prevailing wage, Motion made under protest. Motion seconded by Jon Sheahan, under protest. Vote called; Board polled: Trustee Sheahan - yes; Trustee Fuller - yes; Trustee Cantwell - no; Trustee Andersen - no; Supervisor Pierce- yes. Motion passed under protest.

7. Continued discussion on possible purchase of property adjacent to Road District Garage. No action; further follow-up to be reported.

8. Reports:

**Supervisor:** Letter received from Department of Transportation regarding public hearing on Route 47 - from Route 14 to Charles Road - installation of roundabouts, July 9, 2014 from 4:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. at the Challenger Learning Center. Brief discussion of intended project.

Proposal received from a service company regarding folding door maintenance for \$286.00. Review of proposal. Are they the installing contractor? Perhaps business solicitation. Supervisor Pierce will investigate.

Food Pantry has advised they are considering paying us more money for rent/utilities. They requested information on past year's utility bills, which have been provided. New commercial refrigerator was recently installed. Open for discussion, more information will be forthcoming.

2014 Education District Registration - July 18, 2014 in Rockford. Registration and Board member attendance discussed.

**Assessor:** No report; Assessor not present.

**Highway Commissioner:** Highway Commissioner Thurman advises road repairs are done; ready to pave, end of June or early July. Busy with shouldering and other items. Patching and road striping to be done. Road paving briefly discussed.

**Clerk:** No report.

**Township Attorney:** No report.

**Trustees:** No report. Trustee Cantwell asks Highway Commissioner Thurman about the possibility of no salting in residential areas, and just do intersections. Highway Commissioner Thurman advises no, and reasons for same; states he will make attempts to cut back in that particular area. Discussion continues. Area is due for overlay; road condition discussed.
